SUMMARY

Jan Chizzonite is responsible for overall company operations and oversees critical aspects of domestic and international projects for the clients of WSP Environment & Energy, a subsidiary of WSP Group plc. Mr. Chizzonite has extensive experience ensuring corporate compliance with regulatory agency requirements, providing transaction support involving mergers and acquisitions, and managing environmental programs and projects related to remedial investigations and cleanups, corporate environmental and management systems audits and policy, and insurance risk assessments. He plays a key role in the development of management strategies and conduct of regulatory negotiations for WSP's clients.

KEY PROJECTS AND ACHIEVEMENTS

- **Transaction Support:** Mr. Chizzonite has conducted or directed hundreds of environmental due diligence assessments at industrial sites and other properties to assess potential environmental liabilities. This work has involved developing quantitative cost estimates for the areas of environmental concern and projecting the timing of expenditures.
- **Compliance Auditing:** Numerous environmental, health and safety compliance audits have been designed and conducted or directed by Mr. Chizzonite.
