



Third-Party EHS Audits for Global Beverage Company, USA

Project Summary:

The Client's Objective:

The client, a leading global producer of beverages, operator of agricultural facilities supporting beverage production, and operator of entertainment and theme park operations, wanted an independent, third-party audit service provider to conduct environmental, health and safety (EHS) audits at a number of its facilities as a supplement to its internal audit program.

The Client's Challenge:

The client wanted to ensure that its internal EH&S auditing program was thorough and effective in identifying all regulatory issues applicable to its facilities and acquire an independent look at its EHS compliance activities from a qualified outside audit provider.

Our Work:

For the third-party audit program, WSP prepared audit-specific protocols and questionnaires, and developed a client-specific audit report format that allowed the organization to evaluate and measure facility performance across business divisions. WSP audit teams performed the onsite compliance audits at over 10 of the company's major facilities.
